Order Declares Further Strike Action Illegal

The following order-in-council with respect to the strike of Local 282, U.P.W.A. was released to the Press Thursday:
"Whereas the Government of this Province by Order-in-Council dated September 27, 1947, took over the operation of the plant and other facilities of Canada Packers Limited in this Province;
"And whereas the packinghouse workers of U.P.W.A. Local 282 have gone out on strike against Canada Packers Limited;
"And whereas the said packinghouse workers have refused to return to work despite an offer of increased pay by way of a bonus of 50c per hour;
"And whereas both parties to the dispute which led to the strike are directed from Toronto, Ontario, and by the expropriation action of September 27, 1947, Canada Packers Limited are no longer an employer within the meaning of the Trade Union Act;
"And whereas the said Trade Union Act does not bind the Crown to bargain collectively or to recognize any trade union;
"And whereas the individual workers are on strike against Canada Packers Limited and not on strike against the Crown;
"And whereas the people of this Province both producers and consumers are adversely affected by such strike action;
"Council did and doth order that all existing strike action against the present operation of the said plant is declared to be illegal, and did and doth order that appropriate proceedings be taken to terminate such strike action, whether the same takes the form of picketing or otherwise, which interferes with the employees in their operation of said plant under the direction of the Crown."
