KILLED IN ACTION

Mrs. Blanche Gardner, Cornwall, has received a despatch stating that Pte. Horace Gardner, infantry, was killed in action on Sept. 27th inst. Pte. Gardner enlisted in the 105th at 16 years of age, was transferred to 26th Battalion, then to 78th Battalion. He was only 19 when he made the supreme sacrifice.

Mr. Wm. Dillon, Sydney Street received a telegram yesterday stating that his son Pte. Wm. J. Dillon infantry is officially reported as having been killed in action on Oct. 10th. Pte. Dillon who was in his 21st year joined up with the 115th in St. John, crossed over to England and was for many months attached to the A. M. C. about six months ago he crossed to France and his death came as a severe shock to his parents, four brothers and three sisters who are left to mourn. He was a grand son of Mr. William Dillon, Market Clerk.

Last week the people of Malpeque and vicinity were again saddened by the sudden news that a telegram was received by Mr. Joseph Davison and wife stating that their son William Earl Davison had died in the 22nd General Hospital, Camiers, France, on Oct. 5th, as the result of a gunshot wound in the head received Sept. 18th. Signaller Davison after completing two years at Mt. Allison, one year in the Academy and a first year in Arts in preparation for a Theological course listened to the higher call to service and enlisted in the 7th St. John Siege Battery now the 6th and immediately proceeded overseas to England. Here his military training and promotion was so rapid that he was soon transferred to France where he fought for two years side by side of our brave Canadian soldiers, sharing in their glory and distinguished valor.

The deceased was only 21 years of age, of exemplary character, clever, industrious, deservedly popular and giving exceptional promise of a bright career. He leaves to mourn besides his sorrowing parents one brother Waldron, three sisters, Lily on the nursing staff in the P. E. I. Hospital; Ruby and Ruth at home and a large circle of friends and relatives who will mourn for him as the nation's loss.

A STATEMENT AND AN APPEAL TO YOU ON BEHALF OF THE PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND HOSPITAL

More than thirty five years ago the Prince Edward Island Hospital was started through the efforts and contributions of a number of generous and public spirited men and women. During all these years the Hospital has been the means of alleviating suffering and of saving precious lives and by receiving many very generous contributions the Institution has been kept up to date in equipment and enlarged to meet the growing demand for hospital treatment until today it is one of the best equipped hospitals east of Montreal. Up to the end of the year 1914 the receipts from patients fees, interest from endowment fund and some small contributions from the city and country districts were just about sufficient to meet all running expenses but with the tremendous increase in prices of everything used in the Hospital the financial problem became a serious one and we have had to face a rapidly increasing deficit which now amounts to nearly \$6000.00.

Here is an illustration of the increase in cost of five items.

And no saving can be made on any one of these items. The Hospital must be kept as warm, the patients as well fed as before prices advanced. No great increase can be made in patients fees as it has been the aim of the management to provide first class accommodation at as low a price as possible. Those who are unable to pay are treated free.

It is therefore up to you to say by your response to this appeal whether the Hospital shall lessen, maintain or increase its usefulness.

In order that you may have an opportunity of contributing Queens and King's Counties have been organized by school districts, an executive of three appointed in each district and this executive will appoint collectors who will call on you on or shortly after the first of November. Please be ready for them with liberal and increased subscriptions in proportion to the increased cost of everything the Hospital has to buy. It is up to you.

Give the collectors a hearty reception.
