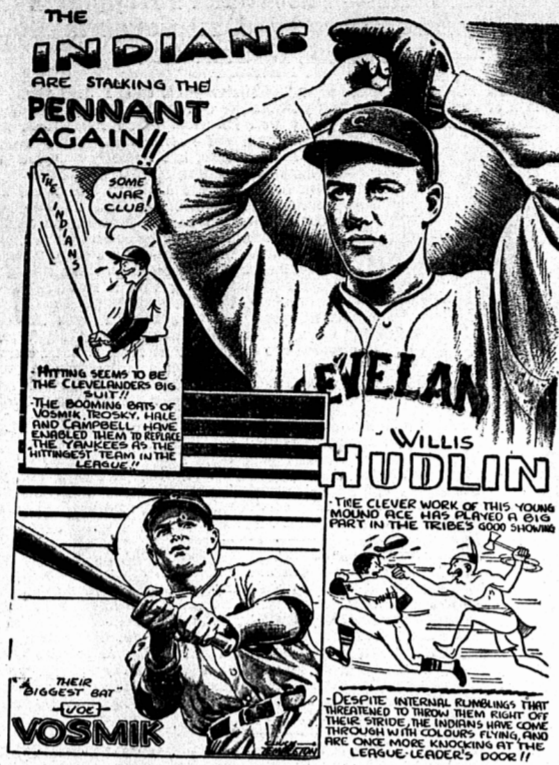
CUBS RELEASE VETERAN OUTFIELDER
