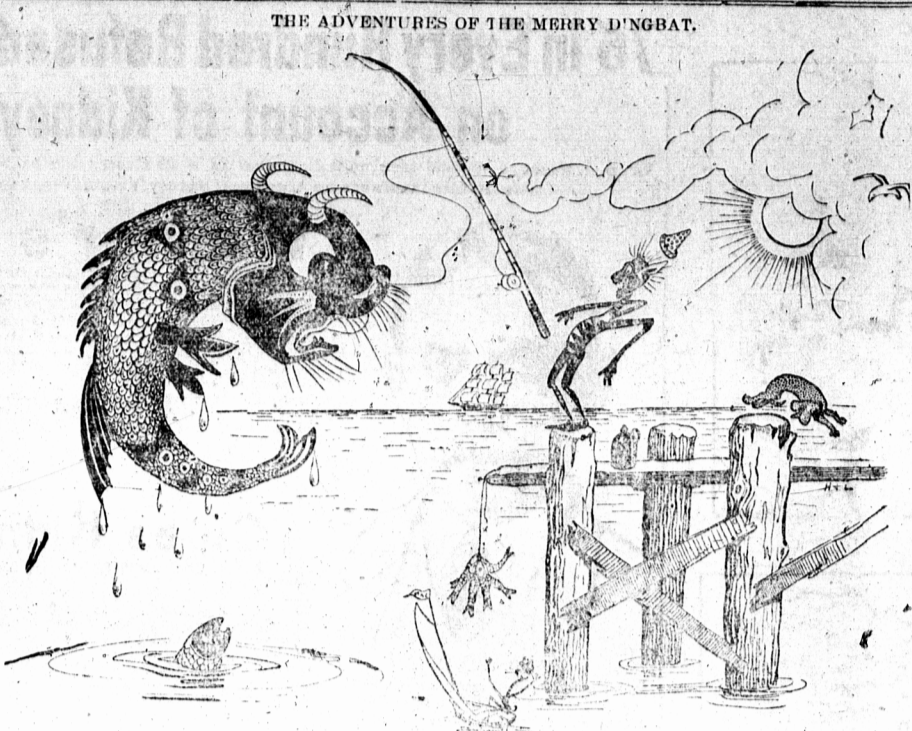

nese battleships opposed to his six, and
why to conceal this fact, Togo fought
in the dim distance, relying nothing and
depending solely upon the superior num-
ber of the men of this fleet.
