TO MAKE THEATRES SAFE.

The mayor of Chicago has closed twenty-three theatres in that city since the terrible fire in the Iroquois. He has laid down the terms upon which they may be hereafter opened. The asbestos curtain is condemned, as that in the Iroquois theatre went partially to pieces in the fierce flames. In its place a curtain of sheet steel will be required. Each theatre must have wide exits, all fireproof scenery, no combustible furniture, and no calcium or spot lights are to be permitted on the stage. There are other precautions. There is probably not a theatre in Canada which comes up to the standard now exacted in Chicago, but that standard must in the near future be generally adopted. Above all things abundance of wide exits with outward opening doors, always unlocked and free from obstruction during every performance are absolute requisites to safety. There ought to be police inspection to ensure that the exits are always available for use while an audience is within.

BIGGEST SHIP IN THE WORLD.

LONDON, Jan. 1.—It is reported that the White Star Line has ordered a steamer 755 feet in length, or 30 feet longer than the Baltic, the largest ship in the world. The construction of the vessel, it is added, will begin immediately at Belfast, Ireland.

OTTAWA, Jan. 1.—Mayor Cook, on retiring from the civic chair, was to-day presented with a sterling silver loving cup by the heads of the civic departments to mark the cordial relations which existed the past two years.

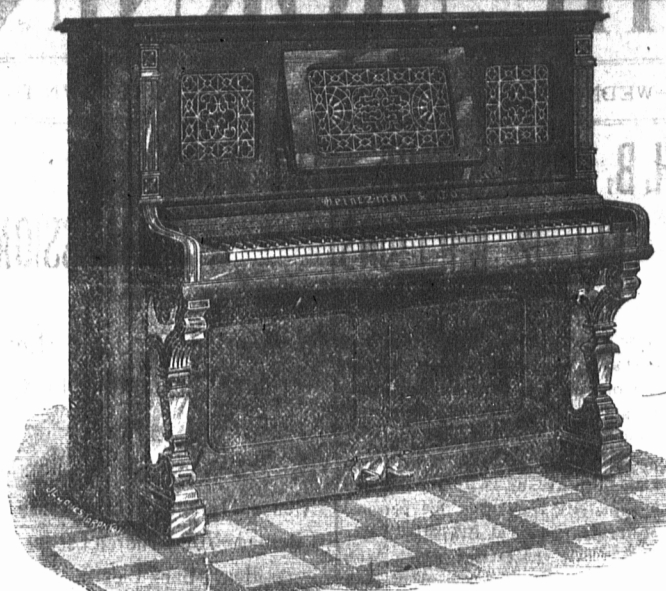
