SUMMER SCHOOL OF SCIENCE

SACKVILLE, N. B., July 24.—The session of the Summer School draws near to a close. In many respects this has been one of the best sessions in the history of the School. The privilege of the school boarding all together contributed much to the social character. The members living together as one large and happy family have become thoroughly acquainted with each other and thus have enjoyed the session. The kind and thoughtful attention of Dr. and Mrs. Borden and their efficient assistants have contributed no little to make this session enjoyable.

On Monday the 19th inst., the annual sermon of the School was preached by the Rev. L. Borden. In a thoughtful, forceful and eloquent address he urged upon the teachers the importance of inculcating in their pupils their duties as future citizens, and exhorted them to secure for the country an electorate that would be above accepting a bribe or in any way prostituting their manhood to the expediencies of any political trickster.

Tuesday, the 21st inst., saw the School off again on one of those excursions which add so much to its interest. Through the kindness of the New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island Railway a train was placed at the disposal of the School without charge. The excursion was from Sackville (to Cape Tormentine). Arriving at the Cape a bountiful collation was given to the School by Mrs. Borden and Mrs. Senator Wood. These ladies by their kindness and attention have earned the gratitude of every member of the School. An inspection of the Government winter ice-boats at the Cape with a description of their use gave some members of the School, at least, some ideas of the difficulties of communication in the winter season. Across the blue strait was clearly to be seen the fertile slopes of Prince Edward Island, giving to the Islander somewhat of a homesick feeling.

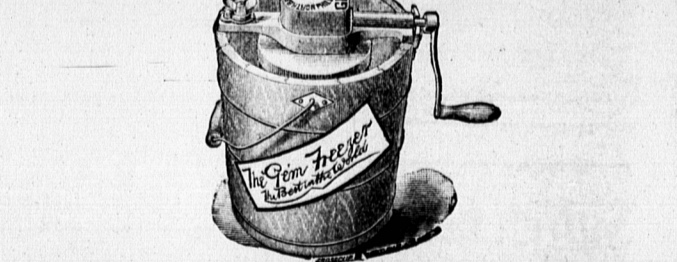
