Barrister Thinks That by Surrounding Boys With Refinement, Some Luxuries and open Air, He Can make Gentlemen Of Them

LONDON, Jan. 6.—An interesting experiment in philanthropy is being made by C. E. B. Young, barrister, of Dalesford, in Oxfordshire.

So great are his patience and his faith in human nature that he is spending his life and £10,000 a year in training boys to be good citizens. While working in London on committees who were inquiring into the condition of the poor, he became convinced that no public effort could deal quite adequately with the question, and he decided to launch out on lines of his own. On the top of Kingdom Hill, near his home, he has built what is practically a luxurious college, and he takes there every

MANCHESTER, Jan. 6.—The wage dispute between cotton spinners and mill owners, on account of which the operatives in two Oldham mills struck several weeks ago, reached a crisis today, when 96 per cent of the masters declared themselves in favor of a lockout if the strikers do not yield by January 18. Two hundred thousand workers will be involved.

year about 200 boys from the poor districts of London.

He clothes them, educates them, and teaches them a trade entirely at his own expense. The feature of his system is that no punishment is allowed. He relies on the theory that the way to make a boy a gentleman is to expect him to be one. Mr. Young is himself a man of culture, and he thinks that by surrounding boys from London slums with refinements, some luxuries, and the open air he can get rid of the influence of their early life.

He ignores all systems and discipline, but there is little doubt that he manufactures, from what is often unpromising material, men who can earn a good living.

If a boy decided that he would like to go to Canada, his fare is paid, and he is given work on farms which Mr. Young owns there.

If a lad prefers to stop in England he is taught how to be a farmer, bricklayer, blacksmith, carpenter, clerk, tailor, agricultural laborer, or a photographer, and in due time work is found for him.

WARSHIP WAS ORDERING TO GO DOWN SOUTH

She Will Arrive at Iquique When U. S. Fleet Round Horn.

VICTORIA, B. C., January 6.—H. M. S. sloop of war Shearwater, now stationed at Esquimalt, has received instruction from the British admiralty to proceed to Iquique, Chili, and to await further orders there. She leaves for South America January 23rd, and will be there about the time the United States war fleet is in that latitude. It is rumored here that the cause of her dispatch is to report to the British admiralty any observations she may make on the United States fleet after the 10,000 miles passage around the Horn, but it is more likely in connection with recent rioting at Iquique. It is likely too she will pay another visit to Galapagos Island, where the British West Indian subjects held in slavery there a year ago by South Americans, have not yet been released.

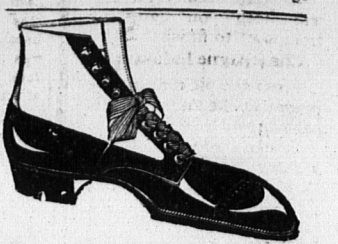
