ATTRACTIVE BOOTHS AT THE BIG FOX SHOW

A feature of the Fox Show, as of the Provincial Exhibition, is the display booths which are attracting much attention. The following attractive exhibits were noted by a Guardian reporter yesterday:

MILLIGAN AND MORRISON

In the south-west corner of the building, Milligan and Morrison, Northam, have an excellent and well-planned booth displaying Purina Fox Chow. The booth is built with an attractive background of bags of Purina Fox Chow. More than one hundred ribbons won at international shows are on display. The feeds are exhibited in tin containers, and courteous explanations are made to customers.

The prizes awarded by the Black Fox Magazine for the largest litters born in 1922 and still alive on Sept. 1 were both awarded to ranchers which produced prize winning litters on Purina Chow. The first prize was awarded to a litter of ten, products of Brockinbow Silver Fox Farm, Nebraska. First prize Blues, 16 in a litter

produced on Donaldson ranch, Opah, Wyoming. The ingredients of this valuable feed are on display in glass tubes.

The following is a list of the ingredients we find in Purina Fox Chow: Cooked wheat cereal, cooked rye cereal, barley malt, cooked corn and oat cereal, wheat bran, wheat germ, dried meat, powdered buttermilk, cod liver oil, molasses and salt which contains iodine.

The following example is given of what has been accomplished by feeding Purina Chow on the Milligan & Morrison associated ranch at Woodstock, Illinois: 8 litters of 8; 17 litters of 7; 57 litters of 6; and 88 litters of 5; in all a total of over 1200 pups from 300 breeding females of which one half were pups, making an average for the whole ranch of over 4 pups to the pair.

BEER ANIMAL HOLDER

To the left of the main entrance is a splendid booth of a most practical nature exhibiting the Beer Animal Holder invented by Mr. Geo. T. Beer, Coleman, P. E. Island, and patented this year. This holder keeps a fox securely in position during powdering, pilling brushing, combing, ear-mitting, treatment of caked udders or raising of young pups. The holder stands on four legs about 25 inches high and 40 inches long. It is equipped with straps for holding the legs in position, and with a wooden yoke which gently but firmly prevents any movement of the head or any attempt at biting. The cost of this valuable invention is \$35.

MCLURE & MACKINNON

Opposite the judging tables to the left of the entrance is McLure & MacKinnon's booth advertising the silver black foxes for which this company is famous. Two large placards form a suitable background to this booth.

AVIATORS PLAN ROUND THE WORLD FLIGHT

SYDNEY, Australia, Oct. 28.—British United Press—Two young aviators, an Australian and a New Zealander, Flight Lieutenant E. A. Gornall and Captain L. R. Shaw, are planning a series of flights totalling 80,000 miles and occupying more than a year.

They propose to make a 20,000 mile journey to and from Japan in a light aeroplane, to fly to England, using the same machine, and finally for the purchase of a larger aeroplane, to make a flight of 45,000 miles around the world, with a "definite commercial purpose," which has not yet been disclosed. Mr. Gornall says: "The flight from Australia to Japan is one of the few grand flights which British airmen have not attempted. The Japanese and Chinese consuls are cooperating with a view to making it a goodwill flight. Our primary objective will be reached on our arrival in London, when we will scrap or sell our light machine. The machine or machines we will then purchase will in all probability be British."
