SEALED TENDERS will be received at this Department until noon on Monday September 30th 1907 from any person or persons willing to contract with the Government of Prince Edward Island to run a steamer of not less than 200 tons registered, and holding a certificate to carry not less than 25 passengers, and capable of maintaining a speed of not less than 12 knots per hour. From Charlottetown to Crapaud twice a week. From Charlottetown to Orwell once a week. From Charlottetown to East River once a week. From Charlottetown to West River, once a week for a period of five years from the opening of Navigation 1908.

Parties tendering to state separately, for what annual subsidy they will perform the service for five or ten year period.

For further particulars as regards the rates for passengers and freight, the days and hours of sailing from the respective places, apply to this office.

Good and sufficient securities must be provided for the faithful performance of the contract.

# THE CALEDONIAN CLUB'S ADDRESS

### Which Was Presented to His Excellency The Governor General at The Annual Gathering And Sports at Georgetown.

The Right Honourable Sir Albert Henry George, Earl Grey, Viscount Howick, Baron Grey of Howick in the County of Northumberland in the Peerage of the United Kingdom, and a Baronet; Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, &c., &c.; Governor General of Canada.

May it please Your Excellency:

On behalf of the Caledonian Club of Prince Edward Island the undersigned Committee beg to extend to Your Excellency a most cordial and hearty welcome to the Annual Gathering of the Club.

We feel that, although Your Excellency does not hail from the land of the Heather, you will approve the spirit which seeks to keep alive the traditions and customs which our forefathers brought across the Atlantic from the Old Land, and which they have handed down to their sons, now to be found in all parts of the New World. We need not inform Your Excellency that Scotchmen and their descendants have ever been the patrons and promoters of manly athletic sports, and we trust that the feats of strength and agility which you will

witness at the annual games today may not prove uninteresting to yourself and the Vice-Regal party.

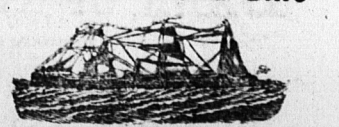
