BRANDY CHOCOLATE DEFENDANTS CLAIM

MONTREAL, Feb. 15—In the case of Walter M. Lowney Co. of Canada, Limited, and others, charged with the sale of liquor without a license by putting a quantity of alcohol in chocolate candy, counsel for the defendants yesterday afternoon admitted that brandy and other liquors had been used in the preparation of their chocolate cordials, but the argument was put forward that these alcoholized candies were not provided for by the Quebec License Act, and that as the act is a prohibitive and penal statute it must be rigidly enforced, and anything that is not included in its provisions cannot be counted as against it. On the other hand, Senator Cloran, who appeared for the Revenue Department, took the ground that the Quebec law provided explicitly that no liquors of any sort should be sold except under license, and that it did not make any difference whether they were sold in "liqueur glasses" or straight brandy or in chocolate cases as "Chocolate Cordial." The mere fact that the alcoholic mixture was sold constituted a sale. And he argued that while the provincial act did not make much ado about the sale of such intoxicants it did demand that none of them should be sold under license. He argued that it had been proved that the various manufacturers and dealers implicated in the case had been proven to have sold chocolate cordials whose main liverer was brandy, and that these sales had been made without provincial license, and that, therefore the defendants should be found guilty and fined. Senator Cloran's arguments were supported by an exhibit of the candies and their contents. He had a glass in front of him, and during his argument his assistant opened some of the chocolate cordials and emptied them into the glass, half filling it with a compound of syrup and brandy. Senator Cloran argued that the fact that the mixture contained a percentage of brandy constituted a breach of the License Act. As proof of this he declared that some of the most experienced testers on the staff taken of these candies and beer made tizzy and sick. He declared that he had eaten some of them, with the result that he had suffered for a whole argued that this was a most spicuous method of supplying alcoholic excitement to young children under the guise of sweet-meats. Claude Hickson appeared for the Lowney Company, Henry Elliott for C. E. Joslin, retail confectioner, and J. C. Walsh also for the defence. As there appeared to be some question as to whether the case came under the provisions of the Provincial License Act or not, Judge Basin took the case on deliberation.
