**Montreal, Toronto Stocks Steady; Decline At N. Y.**  
NEW YORK, March 2 — (AP) — A small overall decline in today's stock market snapped a three-day rally.  
Final prices showed a narrow margin of losses over gains. Most changes were fractional.  
In sharp contrast to unusually slow trading was the negotiation of one of the largest deals in the recent history of the exchange. A block of 100,000 shares of Western Air Lines sold at 1-2 for a loss of 1-2.  
Trading otherwise was skimpy even for these days of sluggish markets. Turnover of 690,000 shares compared with 720,000 yesterday.  
Prices tended downward soon after an indecisive opening. Support developed almost immediately, though, and for the balance of the session quotations saw-sawed in a narrow range. Faint signs of sharper buying interest developed later in the day.  
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks dipped 2 of one point to 62.6.

**At Montreal**  
MONTREAL, March 2 — (CP) — Prices generally were steady to slightly easier in dull dealings on the Montreal Stock Exchange and Curb Market today. Near the final hour a few leaders sparked trading and saved the day for a number of issues.  
A general down grade threatened in forenoon as anxieties over Wall Street opened with an undecided trend, leaving investors here without leadership.  
Canadian Vickers, Common and preferred, were in the limelight, soaring 6 1-2 and nine points, respectively. The Preferred closed at a new high of 150.  
An official of the curb market said that hints of a re-organization of the company was responsible for the sudden outburst. This was the second time in a few months that the stocks jumped to new highs for similar reasons.  
Other price adjustments mostly were held down to fractions.  
Senior oils were on a soft decline, utilities and papers were about mixed while beverages were edging into lower ground. Metals brightened in a narrow list.  
Industrial and mines were traded on light turnover, with the total sales estimated at approximately 126,600 shares against Tuesday's 136,600.

**At Toronto**  
TORONTO, March 2 — (CP) — Base metals and western oils held steady in the dull action on the Toronto stock exchange today. Junior goods weakened slightly. Several base metal issues lost part of the gains chalked up in two earlier sessions.  
Hudson Bay, and International Nickel dipped fractions while Noranda added 3-8 at 54 5-8. Sherritt Gordon was active for a slight advance and Pind Oreille climbed 15 cents at \$5.25.  
Hollinger, ex-dividend today, gained 1-8 in senior goods while Conwest featured the juniors for a 1-4-cent advance. Cochenour, Kirkland Lake, Madsen and San Antonio were easier.  
Western oils were about balanced in a two-day movement. Foot-hills gained 10 cents and Calgary and Edmonton lost five cents.  
The exchange's closing index showed gains down 29 at 92.36, base metals up 19 at 96.86, western oils up 15 at 48.17.  
Gold listed 2 gains, 43 losses, 41 unchanged; base metals, 11 gains, 9 losses, 7 unchanged; western oils, 6 gains, 4 losses, 7 unchanged.
