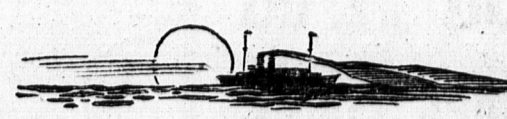
There ensued a Homeric struggle in which man and beast actually wrestled for life in the presence of an excited crowd. And the man and the leopard!

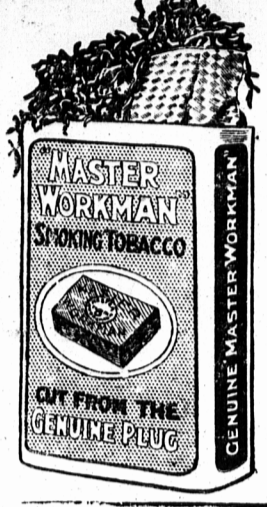

42,000 WORKMEN TO STRIKE.

Forty-two thousand union workers, employed in packing plants throughout the United States went out on strike in protest against wage reductions, averaging 10 per cent., authorized by plant assemblies, under the shop representation plan in the packer industry, according to officials of the Amalgamated Meat Cutters and Butcher Workmen of North America, which authorized the strike. Two hundred policemen, including mounted police, motorcycle squadrons, and patrolmen and plainclothesmen have been assigned to strike duty, and were ordered to appear at the Chicago stockyards.
