

### OYSTERS PREPARED IN THE CHAFFING DISH

Oyster Pan Roast—Put tablespoon of butter in chaffing dish. When it creams add 12 large oysters and half pint juice, with salt and pepper. Cover and cook two minutes. Serve on hot toast moistened with juice.

Oysters Fried in Batter—Make a batter of three eggs, three table-spoons of milk, one tablespoon of flour. Season with salt and pepper. Put one tablespoon of butter in chaffing dish, and when hot drop oysters one at a time in the batter, then in the butter, and fry a rich brown.

Celeried Oysters—Put teaspoon of butter in chaffing dish and when melted add 12 large oysters and one tablespoon minced celery. Season with salt and pepper. Cook three minutes, add wine glass of sherry and cook two minutes. Serve on toast.

### HOUSEHOLD HINTS

To make pigs in blankets, wrap large fresh oysters each in a slice of bacon, using wooden toothpicks to tie the blankets together. Serve on oast.

If you bake bread expressly for sandwiches, see that it is baked in small square bread tins, with the sides rising from the bottom at a right angle.

To make cheese straws, roll pastry thin, cover half of it with grated cheese, fold the other half over and cut into long, narrow strips. Bake till brown.

Choose very simple things for informal evening refreshments—cane and grape juice, or chocolate and waters, or cheese, toasted crackers and cider.

After washing cream serge, put two tablespoonfuls of powdered borax in half a pail of cold water and steep the serge in it for 15 minutes. Then rinse and dry.

Whole wheat cooked over night in a double boiler is a delicious breakfast cereal, but to be perfect it should have half a cupful of rich milk stirred into it before serving.

Everybody doesn't know that the ugs which curl up in corners may be buttoned down. Fasteners for the purpose are to be had in the shops.

To clean the inside of a silver teapot, let it stand over night, with a paste made of soda, vinegar and flour. Wash off in the morning.

A novel currant jelly sauce is made by separating a tumbler of currant jelly into small pieces. Add one and one-half tablespoonfuls of chopped fresh mint leaves and tiny shavings from the rind of a quarter orange.

One of the easiest and cheapest marmalades to make, for families which like a sweet for breakfast and afternoon tea, is orange. Several glasses may be made with one orange one lemon and the necessary water and sugar.
