## WHAT'S WHAT FOR CHRISTMAS

A Short Description of What Messrs Stanley Bros are Showing

Viewed from the standpoint of one who requires a gift for a friend and has not decided just what to buy, upon entering this store, something on display immediately strikes one as being just the article required.

Hand crocheted jackets in dainty colors from 85c to \$1.50 each. Perhaps such a thing as a nice fine muslin dress which costs from \$1.00 up or a warm wool hood at 30c or 50c would be better. Some babies want a fur cap which costs \$1.95 and \$2.35 each, while another, a nice cozy bearskin coat which can be bought from \$2.35 up.

Now, for the little boys who are so hard on their stockings, they have heavy all-wool hose which cost 25c a pair, while the cashmere ones come at 35c, 45c, a pair. A boy, no matter what age, always wants a sweater and Stanley Bros. can give you these in different colors from 80c each or he may be one of those boys whose mitts are always getting wet giving him cold fingers. For such a boy as this they have warm double wool mitts at 25c, 35c and real "mustangs" at 25c. pr. Again a shopping bag which can be procured from 50c. to \$5.00 each, a nice umbrella which costs \$3.85 or whatever one wants to pay for it, or some linen handkerchiefs which can be obtained at Stanley's for \$1.10, \$1.50 or \$2.85 a dozen, will be found somewhere among their numerous wares. For the head of the family, of course that's the father, one may pick out a nice umbrella at \$4.25, fur-lined gloves \$4.50 a pair; a dozen collars at \$1.50 or \$2.00 a couple of nice shirts at \$1.25 each, a suit case \$6.50 up. 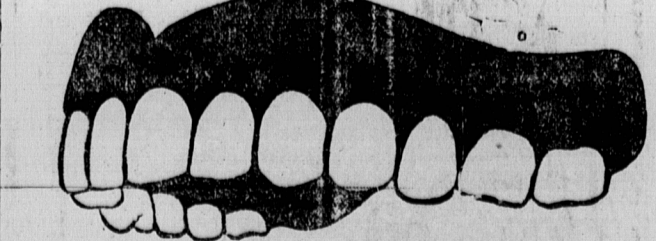
