LONDON, August 17.—In the Bow street police court Matilda Stanley, a middle aged married woman, was charged with maliciously libelling Lady Gwendolen Cecil. Counsel did not read the libel. Only recently the prisoner was found in possession of large quantities of printed leaflets containing a libel, which had been distributed from her carriage. Lady Gwendolen is a daughter of the late Marquis of Salisbury and a sister of the present holder of the title. The prisoner was formerly organist of the Hatfield church. She was married there in 1883, Lord William Cecil officiating. The prisoner was remanded on bail.

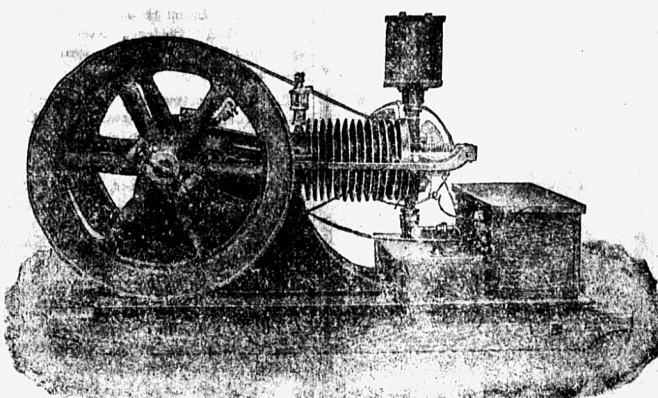
