Look After Your Brushes

As soon as you finish work, take a sheet of newspaper and wrap up all surplus paint on to this. That the brushes are comparatively clean. Place a little methylated spirits in a jar and wash the brushes in this until they are quite clean. If they are to be used again, place in a jar containing a little paraffin, then make a circle of cardboard to fit the jar, and then make two holes in the cardboard to slip the brush handles through. This prevents the bristles from resting on the bottom of the jar and becoming out of shape.
