LONDON, THE DIGNIFIED.

London holds itself rigidly aloof from rivalry with the great cities of the continent. It permits Berlin and Paris to boast of their attractions in order to lure the American tourist; for itself it seems content to say:

"Here I am, the greatest city in the world, with unrivalled museums and picture galleries, not to mention tailors and dressmakers. Come and see me if you want to, but if you don't want to—well, I dare say I'll be able to get along without you."

Berlin and Paris are now in open competition. Berlin thinks it is a more fascinating city than Paris, and it intimates that its night life is far and away more alluring than Paris'. It boasts that some of its all-night restaurants don't take down the shutters until midnight, while Paris, excepting a few places on the Montmartre, is yawning sleepily at three in the morning and thinking of going to bed.

Paris, despite the modernness of Berlin and its nocturnal brilliancy, continues to be the Mecca of Americans, men and women. Berlin's shops of course, cannot compare with those of Paris, although its restaurants and beer halls are in many details the equal of those of Paris.

A rare example of feminine nerve comes from England. Anxious to obtain unique photographs for sale in connection with a church, Miss Lydia Akiens, 19, climbed a steeplejack's ladder to the top of the holy spire of St Mark's Church, Leicester, which is more than 200 feet high.
