### IN MEMORIAM

GUNNER DAMIEN W. F. LEONARD

A telegram was received yesterday by Rev. Maurice McDonald, announcing the death in St. John, N. B., of Gunner Damien W. F. Leonard. Gunner Leonard was a son of Mr. William Leonard, Cornwall, and enlisted with the 9th Siege Battery a few months ago. He had drilled in St. John for some time and visited his home on furlough about three weeks ago. He was then in the best of health and about a week ago the first intimation of his illness was received. He was not then considered seriously ill and no particulars have been received as to the nature of his illness. The body will arrive this evening accompanied by the mother and sister who went to St. John on learning of his illness. The remains will be forwarded to the late home in Cornwall. There are left to mourn his father and mother, two sisters, the Misses Loretta at home and Ella, teacher in Queen Square School, Charlottetown, and three brothers, Ernest at home, Vincent, in the Bank of Montreal, Mahone Bay, N. S., and Louis of the Dominion Express Co., Charlottetown. The family and relatives will have the deepest sympathy of the community in their sad bereavement. Funeral notice will be given later.

### Preparing For Peace Conference
