Socialist Sunday Schools in London

Teachers Sowing Seeds of Discontent—The Extent to Which the Socialist Movement Has Spread—Some Alarm Felt About the Matter

LONDON, May 25.—For some time past the London County Council has granted on Sunday the use of its school buildings in various districts to the Socialists, who held what they call Socialist Sunday-school services for children.

'Good afternoon, comrades!' 'Good afternoon, comrade!' This was the interchange of greetings between the Socialist superintendent and an eighty little children in a Sunday-school held in the Council school in the North End road, Fulham, this afternoon. It was a quaint scene. Eighty children with forty Socialist parents interspersed among them sat in a classroom. The children were fresh faced and happy, white-petted and smiling. The men and women were sad faced.

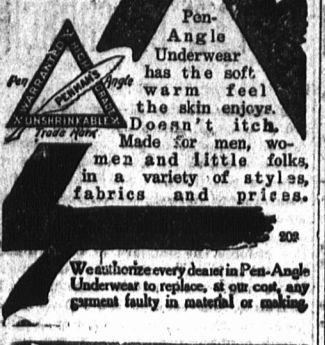

FRANCE, JAPAN, AND BRITAIN

St. Petersburg, May 25.—The Paris correspondent of the 'Russ', in a despatch to his paper published today, announced that he had obtained information from alleged authentic sources to the effect that the Franco-Japanese agreement now in course of negotiation will contain secret conditions applying to the eventualities of a European war, and binding Japan to place at the disposition of France three hundred thousand men, while the British will land a contingent of from a hundred thousand to a hundred and fifty thousand men. Great Britain and France, it is added, not only guarantee the inviolability of Japanese territory, but also engage to float several loans. The statements made are received with incredulity in diplomatic circles here.

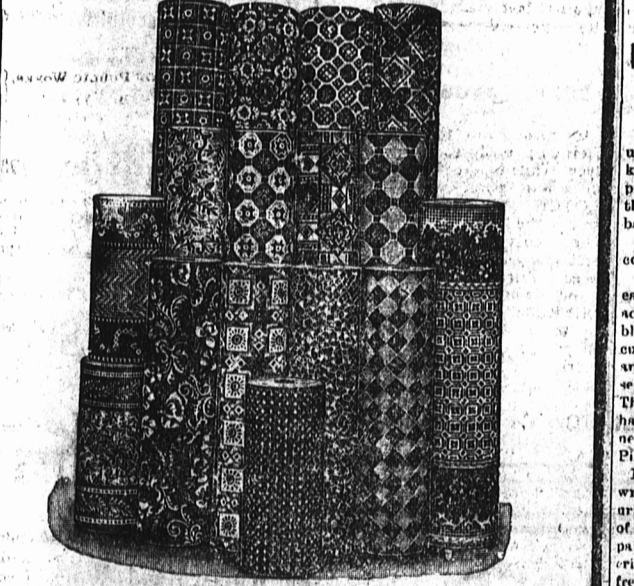

ARREARS OF TAXES

NOTICE TO DEFAULTERS

Notice is hereby given that the Act passed by the Legislature in 1907, to provide a more speedy and simple method for the collection of Arrears of Taxes, will be put into force at once for the collection of Arrears of 1906 and all previous years. The new Act does not require proceedings to be taken against the land, the advertising of the same, the filing of Final Notices to Defaulters; and it gives the Government the additional power, after the Tax is one month over due, of sending the matter to the Court, and of laying on all goods and chattels found on the premises or in possession of the party sued. Where there are no goods and chattels, or not sufficient to levy on, proceedings will be taken against the land under the old Act as heretofore. The new Act, as well as the old, declares all taxes to be "Crown debts," having priority over all other claims, Judgments, Mortgages, Bills of Sale etc. All Taxes will be sued for in the name of the King. Persons in Arrears for Land, Road or Income Tax are requested to make immediate payment to save expenses. This Notice is in full. S. F. REID, Provincial Treasurer.
