### Canada's Trade Growth

Canada's trade figures for the first six months of 1911 show a material increase over those for the same period of last year. The trade as given recently by the Department of Trade and Commerce are for the six months ending September, 1911, amounting to \$400,278,551, as against \$366,277,204 for the 1910 period.

The September trade totalled \$49,425,425 as against \$44,650,425 for September, 1910. Imports for the six months amounted to \$226,491,094, domestic exports \$129,096,362, and foreign exports \$129,096,362. The 1910 figures were imports \$227,615,647, domestic exports \$127,125,412, and foreign exports \$127,125,412.
