M. C. A., thus winning for Georgetown the proud distinction of being the first district in the province to wind up the Campaign with one hundred per cent payment of pledges. However other Districts are pushing right along—Summerside, Montserrat, Charlottetown, Cornwall and Pownall are all doing magnificent work, and it is felt that every man and boy interested will do his individual utmost not to fall short of Georgetown's splendid record.

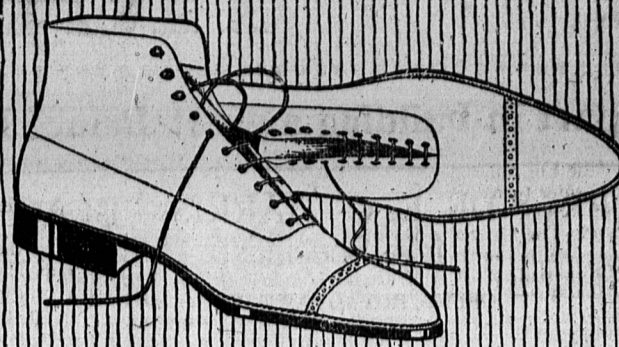
