MEMBER FOR YUKON HAD STORMY TIME

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 30.—After a trip filled with horrors of the frozen north, with an experience of shipwreck, long "Mush" over fields covered with snow back to the starting point, a dash behind Eskimo dogs through the wilds of the Yukon, and a hundred-mile ride by stage coach added to it, Dr. Alfred Thompson, member of the Canadian Parliament for the Yukon territory, arrived yesterday in Los Angeles. 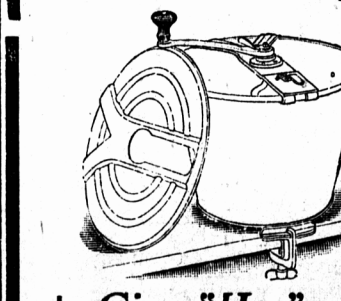

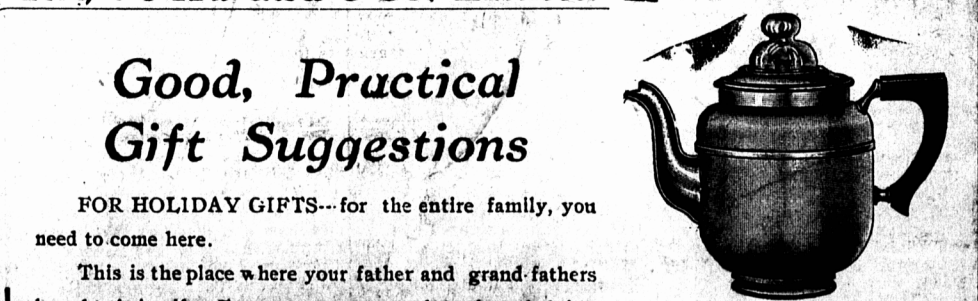
