The Presbyterian congregations of Alberton, Tignish, Bloomfield and West Cape are holding a re-union in the Presbyterian Church, Alberton on the first Sabbath of September, the occasion being the unveiling of a tablet in the memory of Rev. Allan Fraser, who, from his ordination in 1855 to his death in 1870 was pastor of the extended congregation which forms the four congregations west. Memorial service is to be at three o'clock in the afternoon so that the adjoining congregations may have a better opportunity to be present. Rev. Mr. Carr of Campbellton, his successor to the congregation of Alberton, is expected to be present, also the Rev. Dr. Falconer moderator of the General Assembly, who at one time was co-Presbyter with the Rev. Allan Fraser.

At Greenwood, the residence of William Wells, Alberton, the marriage of his youngest daughter Miss Jessie to Frederic Clark of the same place, will be solemnized at 11.30 this morning. The Rev. H. G. Gratz, minister of the Presbyterian Church at Alberton, will perform the ceremony and will be assisted by Rev. D. J. Fraser of Montreal and Rev. J. K. Fraser of Charleston, S.C. The bride will be simply and becomingly dressed in white organdie and will be attended by her sister Miss Annie Wells, while Arthur Clark will perform the duties of groomsmen. Only the families of the bride and groom will be present, and immediately after the ceremony the newly married couple will start on a short wedding journey, after which they will reside at Alberton.

**GETTING READY AT OLD MCGILL**

MONTREAL, Aug 28—The advance of the army of students who will invade Montreal in the course of the next three weeks is now in the city, and the McGill grounds are beginning to show life after the quiet, lumberous days of midsummer. The advance guard is made of some ninety students of the class of 1909. Science, and their present occupation is the perennial measuring up of the McGill grounds. The grounds have been measured up every spring and autumn for so many years back that there is no reason to believe that a square millimetre has escaped the eye of youthful science. Still the measuring goes on with all the seriousness of the past and the more youthful members of the faculty are given their first lesson in the art of chain and angular surveying. The Westmount mountain will be the next field of activity for the embryo civils, miners and electricals.

The science classes of 1908 and 1907 are engaged in similar, but more advanced work at Beaconsfield in the after-noon course inaugurated some years ago. As usual Law will be the first faculty to settle down to regular sessional work, the opening day being Tuesday, September 11th. On Wednesday, September 13th, lectures will begin in all the other faculties.

The McGill Union, around which will centre the social life of the students, is now receiving the finishing touches, and in all probability will be thrown open to the student body some time in October.

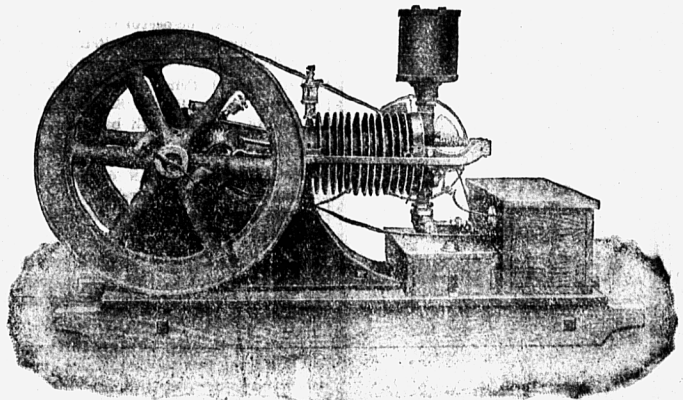
