WANDERERS BEAT OTTAWA AFTER STRENUOUS GAME.

MONTREAL, Feb. 21—Ottawa, the Stanley Cup holders, met defeat for the first time this season, the Wanderers lowering their colors here Saturday night by a score of 7 to 5.

A crowd of nearly 7,000 jammed itself into the Arena, and the match was worthy of the occasion. The play ended at the same time force the it began, and at no time during the sixty minutes did the pace lag. Montrealers have witnessed more brilliant games, but never one more strenuous. The teams were never more than one goal apart till the last ten minutes when the Wanderers scored two in succession. The score was tied no less than five times, the clubs dividing the first ten games which consumed forty-seven minutes of the playing time.

Small, a Montrealer, who had just quit the Cobalt team, played with Ottawa, but as rover was out of position and did not play up to his reputation as a star.

Apart from the scoring the Wanderers outplayed Ottawa to a greater extent than the result indicated. Only Lesueur's work guarding the goal cage kept the battle even so long. He made ten stops in the first three minutes of the second half and was not beaten once during the fusillade. During the same time Hern the Wanderers' goal-keeper, never touched the puck.

At half time the score was 3 to 3. Another five minutes of the second half the Wanderers scored and led for the first time. Two minutes later Ottawa evened up. Eight minutes desperate play followed until the Wanderers went to the front again. Then Lake, by one of the most brilliant plays of the game, made an end to end dash and put Ottawa in the game again. After scoring Lake went to go to the dressing room to have his battered head patched up. In the next three minutes the Wanderers scored twice and the lead of two was

It is learned that the underwriting of \$1,750,000 has been taken by J.M. Robinson & Sons, of St. John. There is every reason to believe the new enterprise will be one of the most important that the city has apart from the Dominion Steel Company.

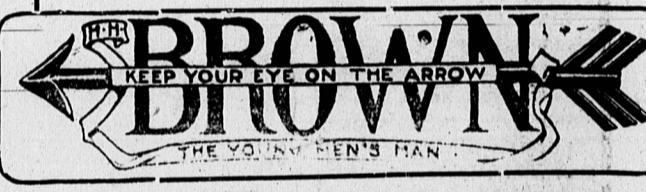
