"The process of treating the coal is very simple. First the large lumps are broken down to the proper sizes for home use, nut for cooking, and small stoves, cobbles for large stoves and furnace use. FLLOWERS TRAVEL 6,000 MILES

Wild flowers traveled 6,000 miles from South Africa to take part in the recent South African Wild Flower exhibition in London, which was opened by Princess Alice, Countess of Athlone. A wide range of wild blooms, aloe and succulents from 20 districts were shown. Many were unfamiliar even to botanical experts. Among them were everlasting flowers, fancy grasses, wild orchids, gladioli, and the wholly leaved, pin-cushion and other plants. Thousands visited the exhibition.
