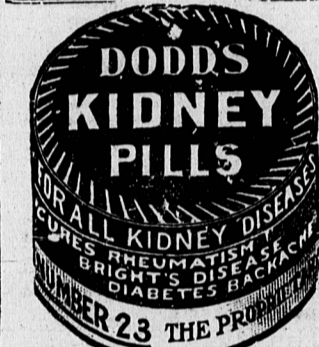

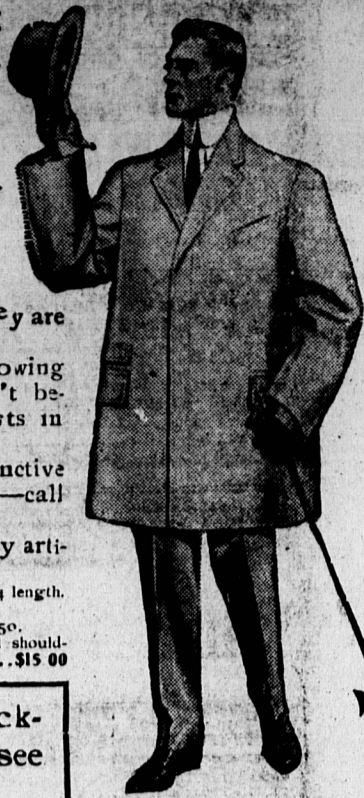
That was the last heard of him and a warrant was issued. He was brought back this morning and sent up for trial.

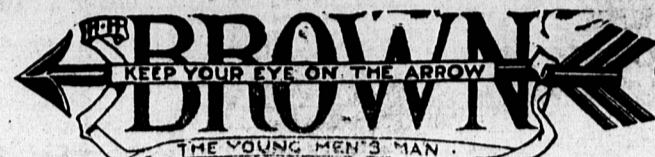
