

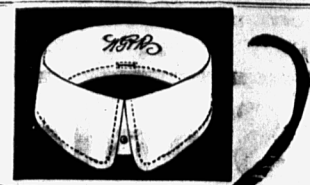

DEAD AT THE AGE OF 112 YEARS

LAPORTE, Ind., 31.—Mrs Ferdinand Reese, the oldest woman in Indiana and perhaps in the United States, died here yesterday aged 112 years.

document in her possession she was born in Volgravit, Poland, in 1794 and after marrying and burying two husbands in Poland came to the United States in 1870 settling at Buffalo, where she married Ferdinand Reese. Later Mr and Mrs Reese removed to Laporte. Her husband died two years ago.

She saw Napoleon when he invaded Russia with an army of 700,000 men in 1812. On her death bed she recalled vividly the circumstances of his visit to Volgravit, which he devastated. With others she escaped by fleeing into the woods.
