TOM LONGBOAT PROVES A WONDER

Broke Fifteen Mile Record Over Mountain Course at Montreal

MONTREAL, June 15.—In a special relay race around the Mountain course last week Longboat, the famous Indian runner cut more than two minutes off his record over the same course on the King's birthday race last year.

The course is a difficult one and the way the Indian covered the ground left little doubt but that he is as good as ever. Local runners started to pace him but he left all of them far in the rear and covered most of the course alone. Speedometers on autos which followed Longboat showed that he was covering the ground at better than eleven miles an hour in the final stages of the race.

After the race a physician who examined the runner, said there were no signs of a breakdown.

Longboat's time for the fifteen-mile hilly and dusty course 1.24.08 or 2.47 better than his record last year when he beat the best men in eastern Canada over the same course.

When Longboat finished, Tom Flanagan, his manager, expressed the opinion that the Indian was as good if not better than ever and that he would prove a world beater in the Marathon at the Olympic games.

At the three-mile mark Longboat was 200 yards ahead of his pace makers and for the remainder of the distance he practically ran alone and at the end of twelve miles he was four minutes inside the record.

MUST PAY TO FISH ACROSS BORDER

ALBANY, June 15.—State Forest, Fish and Game Commissioner Whipple today announced that the state would exact a fee from all Canadian fishermen fishing in New York State waters along the border line. The tax would be \$5 for a single rod, and \$10 for a family rod. This action is taken as a result of the Canadian Government imposing a similar fee upon American fishermen using Canadian waters.

SUFFRAGETTES HAVE BIG MARCH

LONDON, June 16.—All sorts of women took part in today's march and union in the common cause of women suffrage. Susan Grand, Beatrice Harriden, Elizabeth Robins, Lady Onslow, Mrs. Alfred Lyttleton and Gertrude Kingston, were among the more notable women that marched at the head of the different sections. Dr. Ann Ash and Miss Lucy J. Anthony, delegates from the United States, led the procession in carriages. Ten thousand of spectators who lined the route of march generally were sympathizers.

ENGLISH MEAT IS GROWING DEAR

NEW YORK, June 16.—An English exchange has been investigating the present price of meat and has made some discoveries. It says:

The price of meat is rising, and the latest Smithfield Market report indicates that the household joint will shortly cost much more. Lamb and green peas may soon prove to be a rare delicacy, for lamb is rising to abnormal prices and mutton and beef are also scarce and dear.

The increased cost is due to the falling off in supplies from America and a shortage of home-bred cattle. The result has been to send up the prices of both English meat and Colonial frozen mutton.

Widespread scarcity is shown by the rise at this time of the year, when prices are usually below the average. With the coming of the warmer weather people eat less meat and more fruit and salads, but in spite of this vegetarian diet, the demand for meat continues greater than the supply.

MYSTERIOUS DISAPPEARANCES

SAN FRANCISCO, June 16.—Much anxiety is felt over the disappearance of three guests from one of the leading hotels in this city. They all disappeared about two weeks ago, each one leaving baggage in the hotel more than sufficient to pay his bill. One of the men is a travelling salesman in Chicago, S. N. Dewey, who represented a furniture house. He arrived at the hotel on May 27. Another is M. Howard, an Englishman, who arrived at the hotel ten days ago. The first day he went out with \$2,000 in his pockets. The third case is that of N. T. Thompson, of Ocean Harbor. He disappeared mysteriously about two weeks ago, leaving his baggage and nothing has been heard from him since.

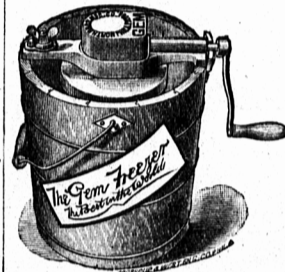
