THE TOLL OF WAR.

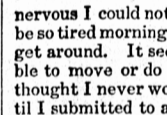

DUBLIN FOOD SHIP

DUBLIN, Oct. 1. (Special)—The relief ship loaded with provisions sent by the Parliamentary Committee of the Trades Union Congress to the aid of the Dublin transport workers and their wives and children, who are in a condition of semi-starvation owing to the strike reached the Liffey yesterday afternoon and was welcomed by thousands of persons, who lined the quays. The food on board was valued at \$25,000.

The strikers themselves unloaded the relief ship, the first work they had done for a month. They carried the food to sheds where hundreds of stewards distributed it to the hungry people, each of rations weighing twenty pounds.

COTTON MEN IN SESSION.

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., Sept. 30.—Mayor William Riddles of Atlantic City and Hon. Joseph W. Salus, president of the Atlantic City Business League, delivered addresses welcoming the visiting members of the National Association of Cotton Manufacturers, after the association had been called to order this morning for its ninety-fifth annual meeting. Edwin Farnham Greene, the president of the association responded and at the conclusion of the session a reception was tendered to the visiting members and their ladies. The convention will continue until and including Thursday and many subjects of importance to cotton manufacturers will be discussed at the daily sessions. Many of the papers scheduled to be read before the convention deal with purely technical matters of interest only to those engaged in the manufacture of cotton goods. For the entertainment of the visiting members the local members have arranged an unusually interesting program.

FOUND GAMBLING HOUSE WIDE OPEN.

NEW YORK, Sept. 29.—A police captain Sergeant and a patrolman were summarily suspended shortly after midnight this morning by police Commissioner Waldo, when he discovered, he says, that gambling houses were running wide open in Chinatown, part of the district under jurisdiction, Commissioner Waldo's action followed a personal investigation in Chinatown late last night. Those suspended are Captain Frank J. Tierner, Sergeant Owen J. Keegan and Patrolman Louis Gray. None of the police around Chinatown seemed to recognize the Commissioner. From the report he made on the police blotter later, it appears that he made a hurried trip through Pell Street and found several gambling houses open. The commissioner found Keegan and Gray in Pell Street and ordered them to report to their station immediately. The suspensions followed.

(Special)—Forty-eight hours' investigation has failed to establish the identity of "Fred Williams," a pretty girl eighteen years old, who masquerading as a man, attempted to enlist in the navy here Friday. George Ferman, chief recruiting officer, sent the young woman's application to the Cleveland office and wrote upon it, "refused applicant a woman."

When the young woman finally told of her sex to the recruiting officer, rather than undergo the physical examination, she said her name was Cora Williams, of No. 1,080 East Market Street. The address is a vacant lot.

"My sweetheart, Oliver Pierson, is in the navy and I want to join him," she said.

The recruiting officer attempted to detain her, but she ran to the door and made her escape.

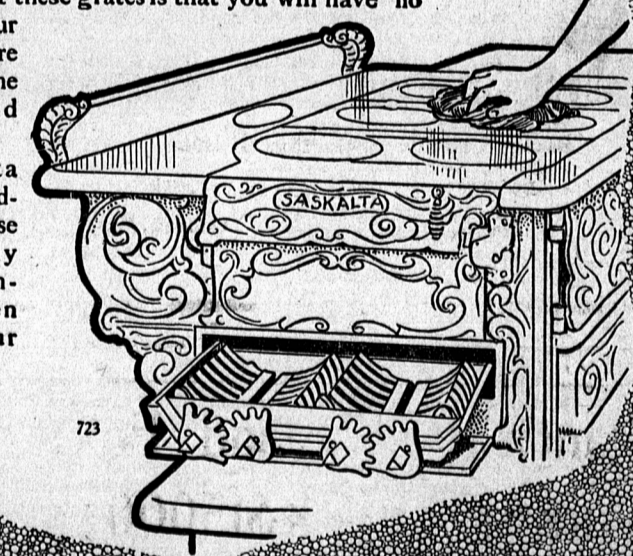
