WHAT GERMANY MAY REALLY WANT.

What Germany really wants is territorial expansion, colonies, ports, commerce. Prussia, the leading state of the Empire, had less than twenty millions of people at the date of the war with France in 1870.

It would be easy to form a pretext for the acquisition of Holland, or the Kingdom of the Netherlands as it is called, were it not that Britain, France and other powers are bound by treaty to protect the integrity of the little Kingdom.

There are those seemingly well-informed who think the absorption of

Holland is a much more probable object of Germany's navy-building than is the invasion of the British Isles. Or, take another possibility, for the moment. There are considerable German settlements in southern Brazil.

But if in 1912 Germany has a navy stronger by one half in great fighting ships than the United States—as she will have unless the big Republic wakes up—then if the crisis were suddenly brought on it seems improbable that the United States would go to war for the Monroe Doctrine and Germany would be free to work her will in South America.
