**CO-OPERATIVE SELLING OF WOOL.**

The Co-operative selling of wool was very successful last year and to further the movement grading will this year be carried on at Charlottetown and Summerside. Samples will be sent to the manufacturers in the entire amount called for. In this way all that the wool is worth on the open market will be received, and by co-operating with the manufacturer all will be benefited.

Wool will be taken in at both places commencing June 12th. On June 15th, 16th and 17th. Mr. Thompson the wool expert, will be in Charlottetown to discuss any question that may arise. Grading will be carried on June 19th, 20th and 21st. The wool will be stored in the Arena, rink on Fitzroy Street near the Agricultural Hall. All wool for Charlottetown should be sent to J. Leslie Tennant or W. R. Reek.

Mr. Thompson will be at Summerside on June 12th, 13th, and 14th, to discuss the wool question, but grading there will not commence until June 22nd and will continue during the 23rd and 24th. At Summerside the wool will be taken in at the Agricultural Hall, and should be addressed to W. J. Reid.

The experiment was successful last year, and the co-operation of every farmer is asked for. Do not wash the wool; do not tie it with binder twine; tie each fleece separately; ship in a hard sack or old sheet; be sure that every parcel is labelled properly, that is, on it must appear the name of the shipper and to whom the wool is being shipped. 300-6-13Mtt.

Hughes, Ambrose Joy, Henry Fitzgerald, Hugh Connors and President Bradley. Father McDonald then in happy terms thanked the Brothers for their kind words and good wishes expressed on behalf of the Society and for the token of their good-will and appreciation, assuring them that he would ever regard their gift as a cherished souvenir of his happy association with the Charlottetown Branch of the Holy Name Society.
