CANADIAN RUNS BIG HORN CANYON

Many Have Met Death Trying The Feat And The Betting Against The Performance was Heavy—But This Man Was Winner

THERMOPOLIS, Wyoming, Aug. 19.—A nifty Canadian has just succeeded in making the passage of the dreaded Big Horn Canyon, winning \$1,000 in gold and successfully accomplishing a feat which has heretofore been considered impossible by the Americans—a feat in which at least a dozen men lost their lives.

The whole town of Shoshoni, at the head of the canyon, was at the river when the start was made. No one ever expected to see either of the men again. The shift left Shoshoni at ten o'clock in the morning, the departure being telephoned to Thermopolis.

BRITISH FORCE IN VENEZUELA

GEORGETOWN, British Guiana, Aug. 19.—Much excitement has been caused here by the invasion of Venezuelan territory by Captain Calder, in command of a small frontier force from British Guiana and the seizure of a quantity of balata (the gum of the bullet-tree, used for insulating wires, etc., which it is alleged has been collected in British territory).

Captain Calder's force went down the Barina River and crossed the boundary in a Venezuelan territory where Captain Calder, at the point of a revolver, demanded that the Venezuelan commissioner surrender to him \$4,000 pounds of balata. The commissioner was unable to resist and gave up the gum. He has, however, made a protest to President Castro and the British consul here against the seizure of the balata and the invasion of Venezuelan territory.
