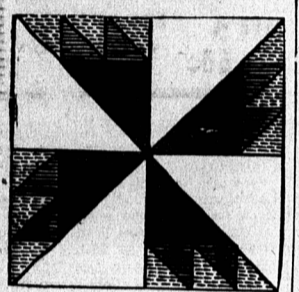
FASHIONS FOR SPRING

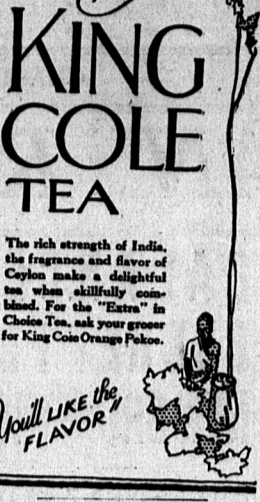

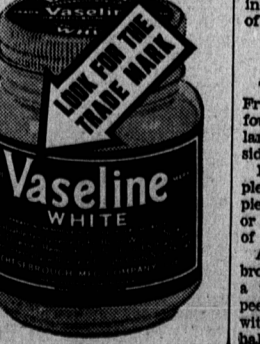
THE COOK'S CORNER

Hollandaise Sauce One-half cup butter, 2 egg yolks, juice 1/2 lemon, 1/2 teaspoon salt, few grains cayenne, one-third cup boiling water.

Scalloped Salmon One can salmon, 6 potatoes, 2 cups white sauce, buttered bread crumbs. Divide the salmon into pieces for individual serving.

Baked Clam Chowder One qt. clams, 1 pt. potatoes, 2 onions, 2 green peppers, 1 cup tomatoes, 2 thick slices pork, 2 tablespoons butter, salt and pepper, cracker crumbs.

Bolled Fish in Potato Border Two cups flaked fish, 2 cups mashed potatoes, hard cooked eggs, 1 cup drawn butter sauce, minced parsley. Press the two cups of well seasoned potatoes through a ricer, letting them fall lightly around the border.
