Mias Millie MacWilliams, Ocean View P. E. I., has received the following letter from Belgium:

Belgium, May 1st, 1916.

Dear Miss MacWilliams:— Your name and address were in a pair of socks which were given me last night and I take great pleasure in writing to thank you. I am one of the boys of the original 6th C. M. R., but at present belong to "D" Co., 5th Battalion C. M. R. There are a great many P. E. I. Boys here and they are very fortunate along the sock line. The Island people are showing the majority of the Canadian provinces the way as concerns sending socks etc: Of course I can't complain as I have my mother and sisters sending me socks but a fellow can only carry three or four pairs, and a wet spell of weather during a trip up often accounts for those. Where we have a surplus sent us. We turn them into company stores and draw them when needed. We are out for eight days now after a sixteen days trip in the last four of which we spent in the front line. I think I had better ring of thanking you again, I remain,

**ROSS RIFLE AND LEE ENFIELD TO BE TESTED**

(From Our Own Correspondent.)  
OTTAWA, May 17—The announcement that within the past two weeks the Canadian Government has requested Sir Douglas Haig, the Commander in Chief of the British Forces at the front, to make a comparative test of the Ross Rifle, the arm of the Canadian Troops and the Lee Enfield, the British weapon, was made in the Commons by Sir Robert Borden today in the course of a discussion based upon what purported to be extracts from a letter written by General Alderson which was published in the Citizen here this morning. In the article General Alderson is quoted as stating that he had issued an order to the first Canadian Division forbidding the men to pick up the Lee Enfield rifles and discard their own but that the experience of the second Battle of Ypres had led him to allow the order to lapse, that the men of the first division had cheered when they learned they were to be armed with the Lee Enfield Rifles and 3000 of them were found to have already provided themselves with the British arm, that a test of the two ri-

It had shown that the Ross Rifle jammed more quickly than the Lee Enfield, that 100 rounds were fired three times as rapidly with the Lee Enfield as with the Ross, the magazine of the former was more easily charged than that of the latter. Sir Robert Borden said that no such letter as that quoted in the article had come to his notice before and that he proposed to have enquires made for the purpose of determining the circumstances under which it was published and the source from which it emanated. "We shall," he said, "at a later date take such action as may seem appropriate in the public interest and in the interest of the gallant men at the front."
