New York Stock Prices Continue To Decline

NEW YORK, Feb. 7.—(AP)—The stock market dropped with commodities today. Average prices of leading shares sank to the lowest in more than two months, with losses to as much as 4 points. When support was shown to be lacking, oils and rails skidded fast, many to new 1948-49 low levels. The market had its busiest day since Jan. 7, with a total of 1,330,000 shares changing hands. This compared with 1,060,000 Friday. The Associated Press 60-stock average dropped .5 of a point to 62.9, the lowest point it has touched since Nov. 30. Rails had the widest slump, .7 of a point, while industrials were down .6. General Motors stayed ahead throughout the day, even after stocks faltered. Principal targets of the late selling appeared to be the rails and oils. Reaching new lows for the year or longer were New York Central which closed at 11, Southern Pacific 42 1/2, Baltimore and Ohio 9, Atlantic Coast Line 40 1/2, Illinois Central 24 1/2 and Standard Oil (N.J.) 66 1/4, among the more volatile issues. Superior Oil of California dropped 5 points at 145.

At Toronto TORONTO, Feb. 7.—(CP)—All groups slid downhill on the Toronto Stock Exchange today. Base metals were in a one-way downward movement and western oils slipped steadily from early firmness. Golds moved quietly with a few senior and junior producers weakening in spotty trading. Only four base metals managed to show small gains. Smelters were ahead in early trading but lost its gains to close steady. International Nickel, Hudson Bay, Noranda and Quement lost fractions and Labrador, Sherritt, Pind Ore, Osisko and New Calumet showed losses ranging from four to 20 cents. Losses outnumbered gains four to one in western oils. Anglo-Canadian dipped 15 cents at \$4.60 and Central Leduc lost 20 cents at \$1.15. The group opened on a firmer note but followed the easier trend of the industrial market. A few senior golds slipped on turnover of small lots and several junior producers showed penny declines. Trading was dull and scattered.

At Montreal MONTREAL, Feb. 7.—(CP)—Reflecting a general downswing on the New York Stock Exchange during the week-end, most selected industrials slipped fractions to more than a point during light trading on the Montreal Stock Exchange and Curb Market today. Papers were heavy losers in a broad list. Penny losses outnumbered gains about three to one in dull mining stocks. Base metals were slowly moving into lower ground along with utilities and steels while oils generally were easier. Beverages were improved in a narrow list. Fractional losers in the paper group were Brown Preferred, Powell River, Fraser and Abitibi, Common and Preferred. Bell dipped 1/4 to 39 1/8 and the Rights lost two cents at \$1.18. Brazillian was shaded, Algamma Steel closed at a new low on a one-point loss. Consolidated Smelters was steady.
