P. E. ISLAND'S ATTITUDE TOWARDS RECIPROCITY.

The discussion in the Legislature of the reciprocity agreement, and the narrow division which marked its close have put more interest into this question than had been hitherto apparent.

Here, in contradistinction to the central and western Provinces, Liberal journals had been lukewarm in their advocacy of the agreement, and Conservative journals somewhat hesitant, certainly very moderate in their attacks upon it.

It is time indeed for the people of Prince Edward Island to seriously consider where their true interests lie in regard to this great question.

To all who share these views it

must be apparent that the large additions to the free list must bring some lightening of our burdens to all classes who have hitherto been purchasers and must hereafter be such, of the large number of articles which under the trade agreement are to be transferred from the dutiable to the free list.

Let it also be noted that it is only by the reciprocity agreement that we can hope to get anything in the way of tariff reduction.

For all these reasons we believe that the more our people consider the question the more generally they will conclude that balancing the many almost certain gains against the possible losses, which must be small, if any, they should take their stand in favor of reciprocity as we believe that will do.

THE PEACE MOVEMENT.

Rev. Dr. Forrest, Moderator of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada has issued a circular to the ministers of that church calling attention to the fact that on April 2 nine hundred meetings were held in the leading cities of the United Kingdom on behalf of the proposed arbitration treaty between Great Britain and the United States.

It seems to me very fitting that we in Canada, who are more interested than the people of any other part of the Empire, should do something to help in this truly Christian movement.

He suggested that special services shall be held in all Presbyterian churches from the Atlantic to the Pacific on Sunday, May 7, in the interest of world peace, and of arbitration as a means thereto.
