LEGLESS VET LEADS PUPILS TORONTO, Dec. 22. - Lorne Groom, former army lieutenant from St. Stephen, N.B., who lost both legs in a burst of shellfire at Ortona, has become a leading

student at the University of Toronto. After suffering the most severe amputation operation in Canada, Groom has gone on to take the forefront in his course at the College of Optometry of Ontario. Dean C. J. Thompson de-

clared. With both legs severed slightly below the hips, Groom uses two-pronged aluminum crutches which render his handicap scarcely noticeable. "I'm no speedball on my feet;

but I got there by studying hard and I hope to graduate in another five months," the veteran said. He plans to open a practice in St. Stephen following graduation.

STAY ON TOP

PALACE SERVANTS' BALL HELD BY KING, QUEEN

LONDON, Dec. 22.—Ogors for the King and Queen and a host of their servants opened the Christmas festivities at Buckingham Palace.

The King and Queen listened to the choir of St. James's Palace Chapel Royal sing carols, including favorites such as "Come, All Ye Faithful." Then the King handed autographed bibles to some of the choir boys.

Five hundred servants and clerks and their guests later danced in the room in which Princess Elizabeth and Prince Philip had their wedding breakfast Nov. 20. It was the annual Christmas staff dance, held for the first time in a state apartment rather than in the servants' section of the Palace.

The King danced with Princess Elizabeth's maid, Miss Margaret MacDonald, and the Queen with her own page, Cyril Hayley, for the first dance. The orchestra played "People Will Say We're in Love."
