WEST INDIAN RECIPROcity.

Probably not much noise, either commendatory or condemnatory, will be made by either political party over the reciprocal trade arrangement recently concluded between Canada and certain of the West Indian possessions.

Canada's total exports to the British West Indies last year, dutiable and free, amounted to \$4,113,276. Her imports from these islands amounted to \$6,469,355.
