Lloyd's Will Build Home of its Own

him, except that he was a careful business man and an excellent host. who, on his death bed, arranged the marriage of his daughter to William Newton who was to be his successor at the coffee house. Few men of such obscurity left to posterity so famous a name as Edward Lloyd.

The Father of Lloyd's

By 1770 the membership had become so large that Lloyd's was far too small to house the members. It was proposed that they should build a home of their own, but this was not agreeable to the man who is known as the Father of Lloyd's, John Julius Angerstein, born in Russia, but educated in England. He wanted the underwriters to move into the Royal Exchange, and when they objected (book rooms there in his own name, and the others followed their master leader. For some twenty years Lloyd's had practically a monopoly of marine insurance; then two powerful rivals came into the field, the Royal Exchange and the London Assurance. For a century these three divided the business among them in return for £900,000 which they had paid King George I. When the monopoly ended in 1824, it was found that Lloyd's was doing 90 per cent. of the insurance business in England. There followed a tremendous rush of competition, every insurance company establishing a marine branch, but before fifty years had passed only a dozen remained, among them, and greatest of them, being Lloyd's.

Russo-Italian Treaty Ready

(Canadian Press)

ROME, Feb. 5.—The Russo-Italian treaty, which will probably be signed next week, is understood to be more of a general than a commercial accord, implicitly including Italian recognition of the Soviets, to be followed by re-establishment of the Italian and Russian embassies. Meanwhile M. Joraanski, head of the Russian commercial mission here, will be appointed Charge d'Affaires, the Marquis of Paterno serving in a like capacity for Italy in Moscow.

The treaty settles all pending questions between the two countries, including customs and railway tariffs, and provides for most favored nation treatment. It also regulates the appointment and functioning of consular officers and settles the vexed question of Italian property in Russia.
