Americans Want Higher Duties

WASHINGTON, Jan. 18.—Senator Gooding, of Idaho, as spokesman for twenty-five Senators from agricultural States this afternoon submitted a list of proposed duties to the Senate Finance Committee. The rates suggested were those advocated by various United States farm organizations. Those which will affect importations from Canada include:

- Wheat, 30 cents a bushel; barley, 20 cents a bushel; oats, and rye, 15 cents a bushel; cattle, 1.34 cents a pound; sheep and goats \$2 a head; swine 34 of a cent; butter an substitutes, 16 cents a pound; milk, sweet, one pound 12 cents a gallon; and skimmed milk 1 cent a gallon; cream, with not more than 20 per cent butter fat 15 cents a gallon; and five cents a gallon additional for each additional five per cent of butter fat; eggs, 8 cents a dozen; poultry 6 cents a pound; hoes, green 2 cents a pound; dried 1 cent; fish, frozen or packed in ice, not specially provided for, 2 cents a pound.

HELD SHACK AGAINST GUN-FIRE OF POLICE TWELVE HOURS

VANCOUVER, B. C., Jan. 17.—After keeping police of Canada and United States at bay 12 hours, John Corwin submitted to arrest in an old shack half a mile from the international boundary in British Columbia today. He was found to be wounded in the shoulder.

Corwin who is believed to be insane crossed over from the state of Washington yesterday and tried to borrow a gun at a house where he was given a meal. Failing to secure the gun he went on to the little home of James T. Wood, Therpe, unoccupied at the moment and locked himself in. He fired or all who attempted to approach the place and it was not until the shack was riddled with bullets the furniture smashed and Corwin wounded that the police were able to effect an entrance. There were no other casualties.

Corwin was taken back to Washington by the United States officers.
