CONGRESS WILL PROBE INTO THE NAVY DISPUTE

It is Feared the Row May Defeat Proposed Legislation.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 1.—Not since the days preceding the passage of the personnel law, ten years ago, has the feeling between line and staff of the navy been so acute as it is today as the result of the refusal of Admiral Brownson to transmit orders from his superior officers, the president of the United States, assigning a naval surgeon to command a vessel in the navy. It is clearly impossible for Admiral Brownson or any of his officers to make public a copy of the letter without incurring the risk of court-martial on charges of disrespect toward their superior officer, the President of the United States. It developed today that a year ago when the Relief was put into commission the decision was reached to assign a naval surgeon to command the vessel in the event that it be manned with a naval crew then a merchant crew and master are chosen from the merchant marine, which, while not finally decided, it is understood will be the case.

Secretary Metcalf again today declined to enter into any discussion of the issues which prompted Admiral Brownson's resignation as chief of the navigation bureau, and declared he knew nothing about the statement of Surgeon General Rixey that the internal administration of the bureau of medicine and surgery had been interfered with by the bureau of navigation.

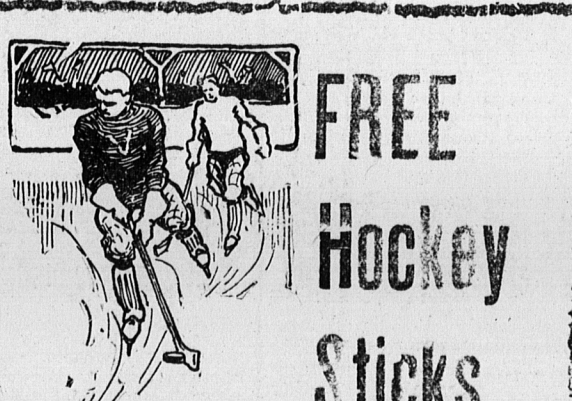
