The dam of this fine young animal is Abbecker Cynthia, with a record of 16 lbs butter in 7 days, at two years and ten months; and grand dam with a record of 31 lbs in 7 days. Mr. Ross's other purchases are two splendid Holstein heifers, from Mr. John Tweedy, Earncliffe. Those heifers are out of Mr. Tweedy's famous cows Molly De Kol and Amy Rooker, sired by Burgey Royal. The grand dam of one of those heifers was a cow owned by Logan Bros., Amherst, with a record of eighty pounds of milk a day. Mr. Ross is to be congratulated on securing such very fine animals.—G.
