### SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

(Continued from page 9.)  
—Luke 1: 28.  
HOME READINGS.  
POINTED SUGGESTIONS.  
By Rev. D. W. Snider.

The accounts which are given of the relation to each other of John the Baptist and Jesus Christ are so far removed from the possibilities of the imaginary or the fabulous that nothing but the acceptance of them as historic facts can bring them into the realm of the conceivable. Unless the records are giving a true history they out-fiction the cunningly devised, and the plots of the great dramatists are as open and ingenuous as the smile of a child.

Why is John the Baptist in prison? Why has he been held in prison so long? Why has there been no communication between him and Jesus? Why has not the power of Christ been manifested in his behalf? What is the justification of their conduct, one towards the other? Such questions and a multitude like them which suggest themselves, however, are foolish. "What went ye out into the wilderness to behold?"

Nevertheless, John the Baptist was human, and the pressure of his circumstances and the questionings of his heart were too great to be endured alone. He sent to Jesus. That is worth remembering. Go to headquarters with your difficulties. Jesus Christ can solve more doubts for a man than preachers or college professors. There are some things, doubtless, they can help you to settle, and, like good men, they will rejoice at the opportunity; but the doubts of the heart—those are for Jesus to settle.

But the Master has His own way of meeting the questions which are levelled at His personality, character and purposes. He always compels their answers to come from the common-sense influence of a reason-based faith. That is what John the Baptist had to do. He had to draw inferences from matters submitted to his faith; and the beauty of it is, Jesus could trust John to do what he was told—and wait the results.

It is worth while to carefully study the character, import and spiritual significance of the credentials of him, self which Jesus submitted to John. Christianity is billed in the New Testament to prove itself by credentials just as marked and which carry as great, or greater, benefit to the world. Can Christianity as you see it present them?

From what we know of John the Baptist there can be no doubt that he was satisfied when the answer came from Jesus; and what do you think about it? Was not the testimony of Jesus concerning John of greater value than freedom from a dungeon?

Do not lose sight of the teaching that the Kingdom of God is not established by violence. Prison doors may yield to violence, but force, as it employ it to gain their ends in this world, has no showing of results in the kingdom which is from above. Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Most things go wrong with those who want nothing to go which does not go their way—whether funerals or dances.

Part-finding is the easiest of all occupations, but there is no occupation which clothes the character with such torn and tattered rags. It is exposed to everything that is comfortless and it has no comfort in itself.

"Go your way and tell," v. 4. The Church of Jesus Christ depends upon faithful witness-bearing. What have you to tell?

"What we have left and seen, With confidence we tell, And publish to the sons of men The signs infallible."
