**Selected Stocks Move Upward At Montreal**

MONTREAL, Nov. 3—(CP)—Selected industrials exhibited upward trends in nearly all groups in dealings on the stock exchange and curb market here today. Selected stocks were substantially ahead in active dealings.

Closing index averages indicated banks up .01 to .2738; utilities up .2 to .765; industrials up .14 to .1241; papers up .33 to .365; and textiles up .68 to .7741. Volume was approximately \$4,400. Industrial shares and 385,500 mining shares. Topping the paper gainers today was Price which added 3-4 on a turnover of 1,475 shares. Brown was active and ahead 1-8 at 61-8. U-1-2 at 83 1-2 was Fraser and up 1-8 at 21 was Donnacona. Consolidated, with a turnover of 2,125 shares lost 1-8 at 18 3-4 and M. & O. lost 1-4 at 23 1-2.

In utilities, Bezzilang added 1-8 at 21 1-4 while Winnipeg Electric dropped 1-4 at 20 1-4. International Petroleum was fairly active in

**Dealings Sluggish On New York Market**

(By Victor Eubank)

NEW YORK, Nov. 3—(AP)—A smattering of industrials and rails pushed up in today's stock market but dealings were sluggish and many leaders were unable to make the grade.

An irregular drift followed a moderately active opening. While advances of fractions to a point or more were well distributed at the close, declines of as much as 3-4 were common.

Canadian issues were inactive. Canadian Pacific was up 1-8 and Dome Mines was down 1-4.

On the curb, Lake Shore dropped 1-8.

Bethlehem Steel touched a new 1947 high, skidded and came back to finish up 1 1/2 points at 101 1/2. Advances of 1 to 2 points were retained by American Smelting at 66 1-2, Skelly Oil 100, Southern Pacific 4 3-4, U. S. Smelting 46 3-4, American Can 89, International Silver 61 3-4 and Twentieth Century-Fox 26 5-8.

Modest improvements were held by U. S. Steel, U. S. Rubber, Paramount Pictures, R-K-O, Universal Pictures, Monsanto Chemical, Eversharp, Texas Co., Santa Fe, Canadian Pacific, Canadian National, International Telephone, Dow Chemical, Du Pont, International Harvester and J. I. Case, Republic Aviation and up 5-8 at 8 1-4 on a big government plane contract.

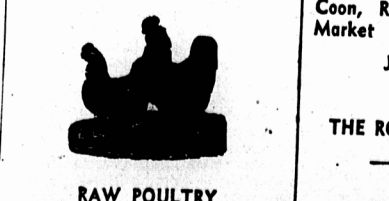

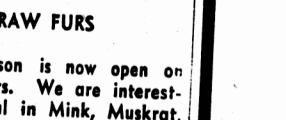
