WOMEN WIN QUIZ IN FLORICULTURE

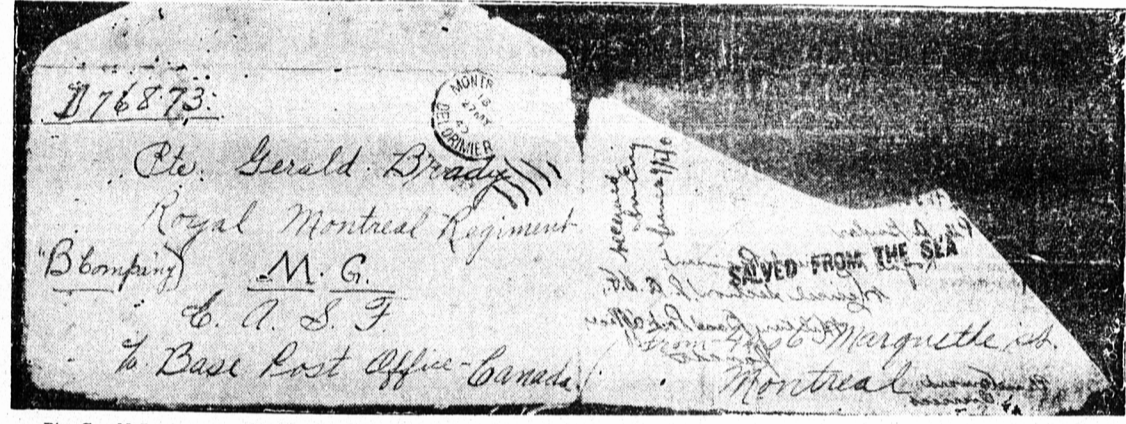

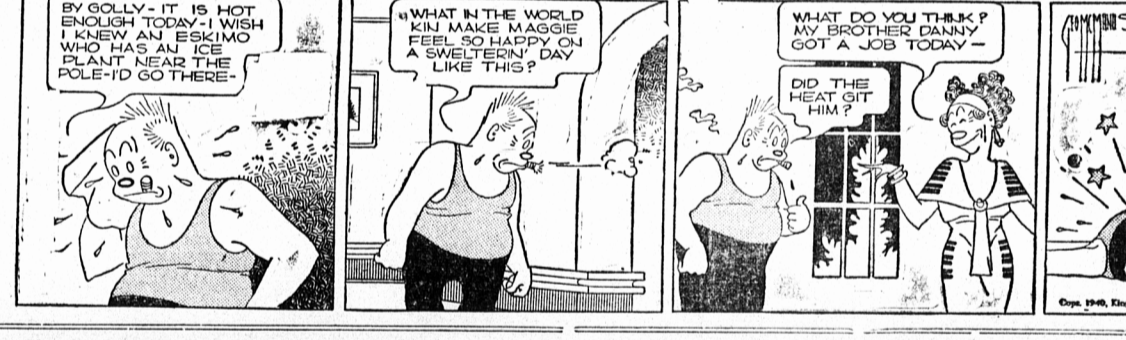
FOUND FIRES DEFLATED
