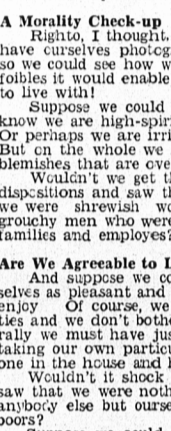

WOMEN LEARN ART OF ROOF THATCHING

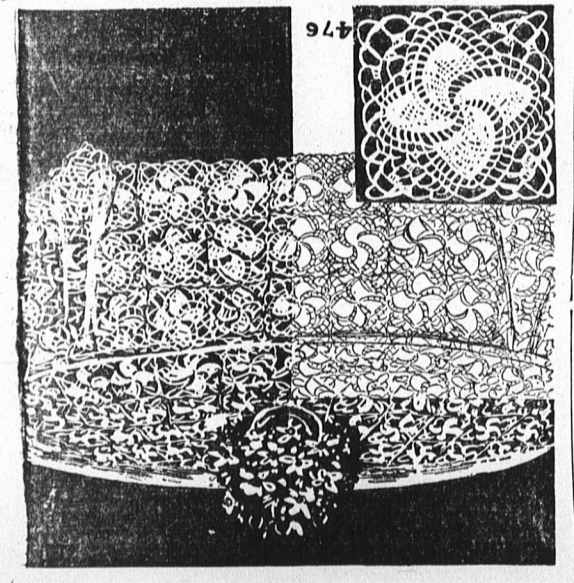
Roof thatchers are greatly in demand. There are only about 200 first class thatchers in Great Britain and as many of them have joined the services their number is sadly depleted.
