KING EDWARD'S BELL AT WOOBURN.

(Westminster Gazette.)

From every bell in the kingdom issued the sorrowful sound of a bell tolled for a great King's funeral. This is the modern application of the old-time custom, enjoined by the 64th Canon of the Church, that "when anyone is passing out of this life a bell shall be tolled, and the minister shall not then slack to do his duty." Only after actual death and at funerals is the "passing bell" now tolled in England. Almost within sound of Windsor Castle is Wooburn parish church, and a pathetic interest will itself to the bell which will toll its last tribute to King Edward from Wooburn bellry. When the date of the late King's Coronation was first fixed this bell was being recast, but it was in its place to ring at the postponed Coronation, as is recorded by the following inscription which the Vicar of Wooburn had placed on it:

The King was ill, and I was still,
The day his crowning fell;
My wound was healed, and I was pealed
To tell the King was well.

HAT-WEARING IN HOUSE OF COMMONS.
(London Chronicle.)

With regard to the etiquette of hat wearing in the House of Commons it may be recalled that a German visitor in 1782 recorded that the Speaker wore his hat over his wig. The spectacle of course was not so startling as that which Mr. Lowther would present if he similarly wore the tall hat or bowler of to-day. The House has always jealously reserved the privilege of hat to itself. James Naylor, summoned to its bar in 1656, came with his hat on, but the Speaker ordered its removal. Foreigners have often noted that while members may keep their hats on in the gallery who do so would be promptly expelled. The Commons custom has been regarded by some as an inheritance from the open air moots of early English history.

HOW TO CURE HICCUGHS.

'Ground nuts', otherwise called 'jars nuts' or 'earth chestnuts', have been from time immemorial a favorite delicacy with village boys, who are now generally barred from searching for them in the glades of woods, where they grow best, by kiljoy gamekeepers. KAISER'S OLD DRILL MASTER.

The Kaiser's old drill sergeant, Robert Lucke, had just died in Berlin at the age of 78. The Kaiser never forgot him and whenever his eye fell upon him among the body-guard at the palace he used to address a cheery word to him.

In 1863 young Prince Wilhelm, then eleven, and his sister, Princess Charlotte, now the wife of the hereditary Prince of Saxe-Meiningen, were entrusted to Lucke to be drilled in military exercises, extension motions they were called, and in shooting at a target with miniature rifles. Lucke left his regiment in 1868 and went into the royal bodyguard, but after a few years was taken into the mess office of the First Life Guards at Potsdam.

The last time the Kaiser saw him was at a jubilee of the regiment, when after the parade was over he shook him by the hand and said: "Well, my dear Lucke, but for you I would never have got on as I have."
