From the report on the Hospital for the Insane we learn that the cost of maintenance last year was \$21,074. There were 188 patients at the beginning of the year and 184 at the close.

It is gratifying to note a number of improvements that have been introduced, which no doubt contributed to the cure and better comfort of the patients.

But the institution is yet far from what it ought to be. It is sadly overcrowded. There is no opportunity to isolate consumptive patients, eight of whom died during the past year.

We trust the Government will in every possible way assist and encourage Dr. Goodwill in his praiseworthy and energetic efforts to improve the Hospital.
