### A MISSIONARY RESCUED FRIEND

HONG KONG, Aug. 31.—Details have reached here of the murderous attack on Dr. Horne, an English missionary, and Mr. Eadie of the Chinese Mutual Life Insurance Company, which took place at Tung Wa, near Amoy.

Mr. Eadie had gone to Tung Wa, about 11 miles from Amoy, on insurance business, and was walking along with Dr. Horne when a native asked him the time. As he pulled out his watch the native snatched it and bolted.

Mr. Eadie gave chase, despite Dr. Horne's advice not to do so, and a mob of Chinese immediately attacked him with knives, stabbing him in several places and tearing an artery in his arm. Seeing the serious nature of the attack Mr. Horne rushed to his companion's assistance and received a very serious wound in the abdomen.

The Chinese apparently satisfied with the injuries they had inflicted, left their victims lying where they fell.

Dr. Horne, despite his terrible injuries, succeeded in stopping the flow of blood from Mr. Eadie's arm and then seized up the cut in his own stomach.

The two men then made their way to Tung Wa, walking and crawling, and arrived there more dead than alive and covered with blood.

### JAPAN TAKING CHARGE OF KOREA

TOKIO, Sept. 2.—Under an agreement reached between Japan and Korea, it is understood that Chinnsewan and Yongheung will be converted into naval stations at an early date at the expense of Japan. ### KAISER AND THE DIVINING ROD

BERLIN, August 31.—The kaiser's latest advice to his fellowmen is to use a divining rod. He has been persuaded of its value by Prince von Carolath, who experimented with one at Wilhelmshohe during his recent residence with the imperial family. Prince von Carolath found articles of jewelry which had been concealed by the Empress and Princess Victoria Louise. Following a subterranean course for some distance, at the kaiser's request, Prince von Carolath informed the emperor that he had found several mineral springs in the neighborhood of the park, whereupon the kaiser immediately ordered that a boring test be made. Prince von Carolath, however, discovered water deep in the sand where the kaiser had been experimenting. The emperor, after thanking the prince, said he trusted the mysterious powers of the divining rod would be made generally known, as such public benefit might accrue.

ROME, Aug. 31.—A most fantastic scene took place here lately in the Via Sistina. Suddenly a young man rode up to the bride on a bicycle, seized her, lifted her on his bicycle and rode off with her toward the Piazza di Spagna. While the cyclist was pedaling as fast as possible opposite the Spanish embassy, a policeman on duty succeeded in catching him by the collar.

An enormous crowd assembled, but then the unforeseen happened. The bride and bridegroom and their friends all turned upon the policeman, declaring that he had no right to interfere. The policeman however, insisted upon taking the cyclist to the nearest police station. Here it was finally explained that the procession and the abduction were acted for a cinematograph, and the only party who did not belong to the company of actors was the policeman.

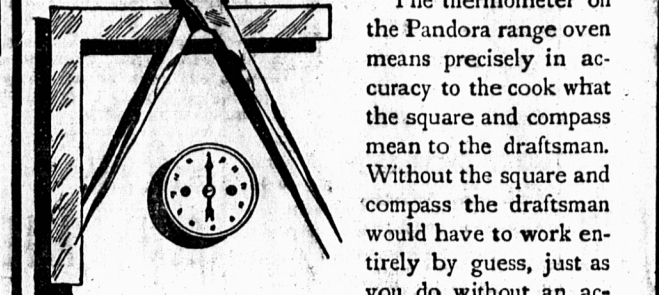
