WILL THE CHINA-MAN SURVIVE US

Is He So Old A Survival Of The Race That He Is Immune—Something Worth Considering

LONDON, Feb. 11—A conspicuous factor in the battle of life is omnivorousness, or diversity of feeding. THE WAY CHILI IS GOVERNED

An Interesting Description of The Manner In Which It Is Done

NEW YORK, Feb. 10—Santiago has been called the City of the Hundred Families, not because an acute social condition might not double the number or cut that number in two, but because the government in Chili is even more a family affair perhaps, than in any country in South America, and because Santiago is the capital. After its separation from Spain and preceding the great war with Peru, there were four presidential dynasties, so to speak, of ten years each, each president selecting his successor and seeing him put in office, regularly and in good order. Forty years of orderly government was a wonderful thing for South America; and during it the rugged little country made money and built its navy and got ready to win the struggle with Peru. Since then, as the spread of commercialism and modern practicality has tended to weaken the sway of the old landed aristocracy, there has been a more or less open opposition between the families—that is to say, the Senate and Chamber of Deputies—and the executive, which consists of the president and his ministers. Chilian government is of the extreme parliamentary pattern, and the families have rarely hesitated to compel a dissolution of the President's cabinet whenever his and their policies did not agree.

In 1880, in President Balmaceda, a man of culture and ambition for his country perhaps ahead of his time, they found one who would not yield to them. Revolution followed, many lives were wasted, and millions of dollars' worth of property destroyed, and the Balmaceda lost. Balmaceda, who was a proud and very sensitive man, committed suicide, but there is a Balmaceda still party in Chilian politics today. And although Santiago is a city of a few families still, in a way, one of the live questions of to-day with its foreign promoters, is labor unions, night schools, incipient socialism, and industrial strikes—how long the country will be ruled by an oligarchy of jealous families, and when these set their minds to be absorbed into political parties each with its well defined policy which, when it gets in power, it can hope to carry out.—From 'Santiago: the Metropolis of the Andes,' by Arthur Ruhl, in the February 'Scribner.'

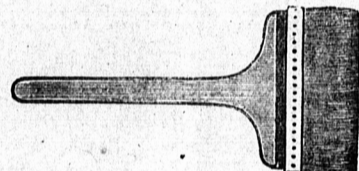

Synopsis of Canadian North-West

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 36, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section 160 acres, more or less.

Applications for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Subagency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may however, be made by the father or mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of any intending homesteader. The homesteader is required to perform the homesteaded duties under one of the following plans.

(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if so designed perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement. The homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father or mother.

(3) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father or mother.

(4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowance crossed in the measurement.

(5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents and or on farming land owned by himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention.

Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent.
